Celebrate the accomplishments of young musicians at this special student recital featuring participants from the Griffon String Quartet education program. Family, friends, and community members are invited to enjoy an afternoon of music as students share what they've learned through their hard work, dedication, and love of music.

Griffon String Quartet members currently work with children in northeast Wisconsin via the **Einstein Series**, a highly interactive program for school-age children. Students participate in private or group lessons or educational outreach programs. The quartet visits schools and classrooms to perform and discuss string quartet music, relating it specifically to relevant topics in their studies and their lives.

Additional **Community-Embedded** programs are all-inclusive for families. The community performances strengthen the musical infrastructure by demystifying chamber music and creating an experiential bridge from short presentations to full classical concerts. The quartet performs pop-up programs in restaurants, coffee shops, businesses, art galleries, museums, and various other spaces. These events provide surprising and fun exposure for the public, demonstrating that world-class artistry is at home in everyday settings.
